### Chair's report

#### Feedback on Visit to Brainwave, Bridgwater

Chair and members of the committee visited Brainwave Centre Hydro Pool, Bridgwater. Everyone was impressed with the set-up.

The water was 34°; the room temperature 27/28°. The pool is raised above ground level and is 1.1 metres deep. There is a hoist which can be used for either a chair or a bed.

The pool is hired out for one-to-one treatments and group session by physiotherapists, insurance companies and a Baptist Church for their baptisms.

#### Kia-Ora Open Gardens, 22<sup>nd</sup> May

Kia-Ora is again hosting an open day for us. Activities include a Teddy Bear Treasure Hunt, a draw and a plant sale. Committee members will be manning the entrance, selling draw tickets, and generally helping out around the grounds.
