Chair's report	<p>Chair is meeting with our Architect in May to arrange a new survey of proposed pool site to enable the start of drawing up Plans.</p> <p>Chair attended a meeting with regard to the proposed 'Garden Village'. At the meeting there was discussion as to whether or not there would be a sports 'hub' (grass sports). This will not affect CSPC plan to build on the north west development.</p> <p>Chair on holiday between 8th - 27th April.</p>
